One or more of the speakers said age 70 would be the cut-off age for not paying dues, but that was inaccurate and we are sorry the error was not addressed at the time.

The ICA Council and I, John P. Kelly, want to assure everyone: The age limit was set at 75 at the inception of ICA and it remains at age 75. I thank you for your understanding and patience as we continue to improve our communications and advance ICA.

### National Coalition Affiliates And Ambassadors
