Mark Pfeifer, the ICA Coordinator of International Coalitions is "excited to see God using ICA apostles with hundreds of other apostolic leaders around the world in creating a worldwide connection of apostles through ICA National Coalitions." The following are condensed reports he has received from ICA Ambassador Apostles. Watch for more details and send us your reports!

Australian Coalition of Apostles and Prophets:

Mark Pfeifer just returned from a hugely successful gathering of Australian apostles. Convening Apostle John MackNamara, said: it was the best ever Coalition meeting! 53 Apostolic Leaders were present from the various States and Territories representing some 2000 congregations throughout the Great Southland. He thanks prominent Australians Dr. Alan Langstaff, Brigadier Jim Wallace, Alistair Coe MLA and ICA Ambassadorial Apostle Mark Pfeifer from the USA, for their extremely thought-provoking contributions!

The Australian Executive Committee met after the conference and invited John P. Kelly to be next year's speaker for their conference. Plans are also underway to have meetings with the New Zealand apostles during that same timeframe.

Brazil: John P. Kelly was invited by Rene Terra Nova (ICA member) to speak at a conference of 25,000 leaders and then talk with a select group of over 100 apostles about forming the Brazilian Coalition of Apostles. Member Josimar Salum is sending more details soon.

Ethiopia and Zimbabwe: Phil Nordin (Canada member) traveled to Ethiopia to launch ECA (Ethiopian Coalition of Apostles) and to launch Zimbabwe ZCA (Zimbabwe Coalition of Apostles).

Honduras: John Morrow is working to form the Honduran Coalition of Apostles.

Liberia and Other Nations: John and Rebecca Polis visited their network of apostles in Liberia in February and discussed the possibility of starting an ICA National Coalition.

Kenya and Namibia: John is working with Dr. Joe Kayo about serving as Convening Apostle for Kenya. 74 year old Dr. Kayo is known as the Father of Pentecost in Kenya. He is the founder of Deliverance Church with over 1000 churches in Kenya; some with over 10 thousand in attendance.

John is also researching Namibia for an ICA National Coalition.

Europe: The Polis's are finding willing people who are hungry to create coalitions in their nations. They will meet with Apostle Sicko Damir from Croatia in September to discuss the possibility.

Functional Successors

If each generation is to do greater works as Jesus said: "The truth is, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father" (John 14:12), then we can assume there is a greater calling upon each generation to perform a greater work. As Proverbs 13:22 says, "Good people leave an inheritance to their grandchildren, but the sinner's wealth passes to the godly."

Our apostolic success is defined by not only the number of those who followed our ministry and not only those we discipled, but how many became functional successors; continuing on with the vision expansion!

We who are in the older generations have a responsibility before God to discern the destiny of the next generation/s and to assist them with their assignment and help them to facilitate it. In order to do so, we must get in alignment with Father God. Generational Succession is a principle found in both the Old and New Testaments. It must be understood and embraced by all true apostles.

The Apostolic Problem

As is stated in my teaching Solutions to the Apostolic Problem—the greatest problem with apostles is what also causes apostles to be successful: the problem of being focused on what they are called to build, who they are called to raise up, and what causes they are given to. Zambia: Apostle Andy Briemeister reports: "On Friday March 11 George convened a meeting with 26 apostolic leaders in Ndola, Zambia - the Zambian way, being sensitive to the cultural ways of introduction and building trust. We (ICA) are not here to colonize but to bless." They discussed the goal of helping each other be better apostles. Many of the brothers said, 'when you formalize this coalition, count me in!' Very good news! Andy concluded, "I expect that we will make steady progress over several months to expand and formalize the Zambia National Coalition of Apostles. My best estimate is that by two years from now we will have a well structured coalition with about 140 members."
